Students must earn 24 credits to graduate, which exceeds NC graduation requirements. Additional graduation requirements: mission experience, J-Term completions and 20 service hours per year. Beginning with the Class of 2021, Freshman Seminar (½ credit) is also required.

GPA CALCULATION

Grade point average (GPA) is based on a 4.0 scale, with the exception that honors courses receive one extra quality point and AP courses receive two extra quality points. All (CCS) high school courses are included in the calculation of GPA. If a student enters Carmel Christian with credits from another high school, a transcript from the previous high school will be enclosed with the CCS transcript. Those grades are included in the CCS cumulative GPA calculation.
