## GPA CALCULATION

Grade point average (GPA) is based on a 4.0 scale, with the exception that honors courses receive one extra quality point and AP courses receive two extra quality points. All (CCS) high school courses are included in the calculation of GPA. If a student enters Carmel Christian with credits from another high school, a transcript from the previous high school will be enclosed with the CCS transcript. Those grades are not included in the CCS cumulative GPA calculation.

- STEM Research-International Space Station is a project-based class structured to design, build, test, integrate, qualify, deliver, launch, operate, and retrieve a MicroLab experiment aboard the International Space Station. The ISS Program partners with Quest Institute for Quality Education and NanoRacks, LLC, via its Space Act Agreement with NASA's US National Lab.

- J-Term, a one-week intensive in January, allows students to explore their passions through local and global missions, college tours, internships and trips with language immersion or an academic focus.
