

International Student Program Admission Procedures

The Admission Committee of Carmel Christian School is pleased to meet with you as part of your admission process. During the weeks that we have to discuss your desire to be a part of Carmel Christian School, we will assess various areas that will help us determine if Carmel is the best Christian school alternative for you. The areas that we consider are: commitment to and desire for Christian education, past educational performance, academic assessment, English proficiency, references, and individual student qualifications.

Carmel Christian School accepts qualified students for a minimum of one year and up to four years. Students coming from non-English speaking countries are required to submit an age appropriate English proficiency score.

SEVIS is a web based system to provide real-time, up-to-date information on F, M and J non-immigrants. The information monitored by SEVIS not to be mixed up with SEUP is:

- A way for U.S. authorities to differentiate between individuals who are in the US for legitimate academic pursuits and those who may be abusing or not maintaining their student or exchange visitor status.

SEVIS and Carmel Christian School require all international students to submit the following documentation below to Carmel Christian School Admissions Department to be considered for admission and issuance of an I-20 (F-1) Student Visa.

Forms to submit by e-mail, fax or US mail:

- Admissions Application (online)
- Student Questionnaire
- Standardized test scores (TOEFL, TOELLJR, SLEP)
- Middle and High School transcripts (translated into English)
- Affidavit of Financial Support form supplied by CCS
- Immunization records
- Proof of Health Insurance
- Current physical or Athletic Physical Form
- Homestay Family Invitation
- High School English Teacher Recommendation
- High School Math Teacher Recommendation

Once your file is complete, you will be contacted regarding your Admissions interview.

If accepted, students will be:

- Notified by email or phone by CCS official
- Mailed their I-20

Accepted student responsibilities:

- Arrange interview with the US Embassy in their country to obtain F-1 Visa.
- Full payment must be received by June 1st in order to be enrolled.
