GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Summer Adventures** is open to families at Carmel Christian School, WEE school, Carmel Baptist Church, and to the public. Click [HERE](#) for General Information.
- **Summer Adventures** is offered to rising kindergarteners through rising eighth graders.

- **Summer Extended Day** is offered throughout the summer and includes fun daily activities, field trips, mission projects and free play time with friends in a relaxed setting.

Summer Extended Day	12:00-5:30	\$125/week

*Exception : May 28-31 (4-Day Camp-\$150 & Ext Day-\$100)

SUMMER EXTENDED DAY

- On-campus activities are on Monday/Friday each week.
- Field trips are on Tuesday/Thursday each week.
- Service/Mission Projects are on Wednesday each week.
- Parents are notified in advance of the weekly activities.
- Campers are transported to field trips and service projects on CCS vehicles by approved drivers.
- Campers will return to campus by 4:30 pm on the days that there are field trips/service projects. Summer Extended Day ends at 5:30 pm each day.
- Snacks are provided for campers during the afternoon.



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DROP-OFF/PICK-UP PROCEDURES

- Daily drop-off occurs between 8:00-8:45 am each morning.
- Parents should park in the main church parking lot and walk campers in through the main church entrance each day.
- There will be camp signs to direct parents to the check in area each day where they will be greeted by Summer Camp staff.
- Parents should follow the same pick up procedures as drop-off.
- Parents should notify the Director of changes to drop-off or pick-up.

REGISTRATION/REFUND POLICY

- Summer Adventures registration is online only. No registration is made over the phone or in person. Click **HERE** to register for Summer Adventures.
- There is a \$25 non-refundable registration fee; registration is required for all participants.
- Summer Camp staff will send confirmation that registration is received.
- Parents must go online and pay for the specific weeks after registration in order for campers to be fully enrolled in the camp of the week.
- Families will be refunded full amount of camp up to a week prior to the camp start date. After this date, there are no camp refunds.
- All camps are subject to minimum enrollment, and CCS reserves the right to cancel camps with insufficient enrollment.
- Every effort will be made to offer camps as described. However, if circumstances arise which necessitate a change to the camp description or staff, parents will be notified immediately.
- If CCS cancels a camp for any reason, families will receive a full refund.
- If, after a camp has begun, it becomes apparent that the summer camp staff has not been made aware of a specific medical or emotional need, the Director will contact parents. If needs cannot be accommodated, or if the camper is uncooperative with camp instructors or staff, or is a detriment to other campers, the camper may be removed from the camp.

MEDICAL NEEDS/ALLERGIES

- Parents should complete the registration form and be sure to note any allergies or medications in order to notify Summer Adventures staff.
- Summer Adventures staff will follow up with parents about specific action plans for children.
- Parents must provide epi-pens or inhalers for their children while they are at Summer Adventures.
- Carmel Christian School is **NOT a nut-free facility**.



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WHAT TO BRING TO SUMMER ADVENTURES

- All children should bring a water bottle to camp each day.
- Snacks are provided at camp, but children are allowed to bring their own snack as well.
- There may be specific items required for campers to bring depending on the nature of the camp. This information will be sent to families in advance.
- Modest and appropriate clothing is required for all campers. Parents should send campers in clothing that is comfortable and that can get dirty.
- Close-toed shoes are encouraged for all camps, but are a requirement for All-Sports camps.
- Campers staying for Summer Extended Day should bring their lunch each day. Afternoon snacks will be provided for participants.
- Carmel Christian School prohibits possessing, using, selling, or being under the influence of drugs, tobacco, alcoholic beverages or intoxicating substances. Violation of this policy by campers, instructors, or staff will require immediate removal from the CCS campus and dismissal from the Summer Adventures Program.
