Timothy Project

Grades 9-12

The Timothy Project is a partnership between the Extended Day Program and the High School at CCS. The primary goal of the Timothy Project is to encourage and train high school students to impact the next generation for Christ. High School students have the unique opportunity to serve others on the campus of CCS in a way that encourages them to move beyond the walls of CCS and serve in both local and global communities.

Deadline for Applications: September 13. Limited spaces are available for the 2019-20.

High School students participate in the Timothy Project in the following ways:

- Play outdoor games with one or more children
- Play outdoor games with one or more children
- Play assigned group games with specific age groups
- Assist one or more children with homework

Timothy Project Requirements & Opportunities:

Days/Hours: Monday- Friday; 3:30-4:30; Volunteers serve one hour/week.

Leadership Training: Students & staff will focus on discipleship and leading by example, not only to the children in their sphere of influence but to peers as well.

Good Standing: As a leader, students should be in good academic standing with the school. They should also lead in behavior and respect in the High School. Those students who are not in good standing will be asked to step down as a Timothy Project volunteer.

Training & Monthly Meetings: There will be a mandatory training day in September as well as monthly meetings (Thursday lunch period).

Attendance: Regular attendance is required; volunteers will be asked to step down if service is inconsistent.

Project 658 Events: Volunteers are required to attend at least one Project 658 event during the year.

Reading Requirement: There may be an assigned book or articles to discuss during the school year.

Application & Acceptance:

- There is limited space for new volunteers. Volunteers will go through an interview process in order to participate.
- Applications are due by **September 13**. Interviews will be scheduled as soon as applications are received.
- An acceptance email will be sent to volunteers by the Director with mandatory training information.
