

Senior Parking Spot Paint- Class of 2022

We are excited to continue the tradition of allowing seniors to paint their own parking spot! This tradition is aimed at boosting school pride and senior ownership over CCS as seniors have the opportunity to "own" a piece of the school. We encourage students to express themselves through positive artwork, to beautify the campus, to build school spirit, and to support their senior class.

Purchasing a Reserved Senior Parking Space allows the purchasing senior student to personalize his or her assigned space by painting it. "NON-RESERVED" or "General" parking spaces will continue to be available for senior students who do not wish to purchase and decorate a parking spot.

- **Who is eligible to paint a spot?**
 - Any student who is a rising senior (class of 2022) and enrolled in CCS for the 21-22 school year
 - Student must apply for and receive an approved CCS parking permit
- **What is the timeline for painting a spot?**
 - Monday, August 2- Design proposals due to Mr. Siftar
 - Wednesday, August 4- You will be informed of approval or denial of your design
 - Saturday, August 7- Paint Day #1 (weather permitting) 8am-1pm
 - Tuesday, August 17- Paint Day #2 (weather permitting) 8am-1pm
 - If we must postpone either day due to rain, students will be informed the evening before, and a make-up day will be communicated then
 - All painting must be completed on these days
- **How much does it cost to paint a spot and where does that money go?**
 - The total cost is \$50- Go to Carmel Cashier to submit payment.
 - \$40- Professional power washing at the end of the year to clear your spot.
 - \$10- Student activity fund.
 - All materials and paint must be purchased by the student. No materials will be provided.
- **What are the guidelines for designing my spot?**
 - We encourage students to express themselves creatively, while promoting a positive message to the school and church community. Specifically, the guidelines are as follows:
 - The overall message/ "feel" of the design must be positive.
 - No offensive language or symbols, political messages, or names of other students.
 - No double entendres (messages that have a double meaning).
 - If you submit a design with an inappropriate double entendre, your design will be denied and you will not be permitted to take part in this privilege.
 - **Tape the edges of your spot with a 6 inch margin before painting.**
 - Do not paint on the white lines or parking lot curbs.

- **How do I submit my design?**

The last page of this document is a design proposal page. **You will submit this design via email to Mr. Siftar- SiftarD@carmelchristian.org by 8:00 am on Monday, August 2.**

1. Your design must be in **color**.
 2. You must follow your design *exactly* when you paint your spot. Any unapproved changes will result in your spot having the paint removed.
- **What happens if my design is not approved?**
 - Mr. Siftar and the approval committee will respond to you by August 4, with the specific reason your design was not approved.
 - If your design was not denied because of a double entendre, you will be given the opportunity to change or tweak your design and resubmit.
 - **How do I choose a parking spot?**
 - Students will choose their spot on a first come, first serve basis on Paint Day.
 - You will not be permitted to reserve or hold a spot for another student who is not present.
 - **What paint are we permitted to use?**
 - Exterior, water-based paint
 - No oil-based paint, reflective paint, or spray paint permitted
 - Only paint in which the label can be clearly identified will be permitted

- **What should I bring with me on painting day?**
 - Brushes, rollers, sponges to apply paint
 - Paint trays
 - Broom to sweep the spot before painting
 - Masking tape to create a clean border around your painting
 - Chalk to sketch your design
 - Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans
 - Towel to sit on while you paint
 - Sunscreen, hat, water bottle, snacks
- **What will the school provide on paint day?**
 - The school will provide trash cans to dispose of materials.
- **What tips do you have?**
 - Sweep the dirt and pebbles off the spot
 - Use chalk to draw out your sketch
 - Start painting at the front of your spot out to the end (front bumper to back bumper). There may be others working beside you and you cannot step on their spot.
 - Consider making a stencil ahead of time for lettering or detailed images to save time
 - Limit your paint palette as the quarts of paint are expensive or share colors with a friend
 - It will take at least 1/2 gallon of *quality* paint to cover the spot if you are using a solid color.
 - Your family may already have leftover exterior house paint at home that you can use. Open paint can at home and check to see if it is still usable before the paint date
- **Please take note:**
 - CCS reserves the right to paint over your parking spot if your parking spot design deviates from the submitted design at any point in the school year. Additionally, if any student defaces another students' parking spot, their parking spot paint privilege will be lost and money will not be refunded.

I hereby agree to abide by all of the following rules, conditions and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved painted parking spot in the student lot (please initial on each line).

- _____ I agree to pay the \$50 fee for painting a spot.
- _____ I must submit my colored design proposal (this sheet) to Mr. Siftar via email by August 1.
- _____ I will ONLY use water-based latex exterior paint. I know I am not permitted to use spray paint, reflective paint, or fluorescent paint of any kind.
- _____ I know I have to bring my own brushes and painting supplies.
- _____ I will create a border of 6" from the white lines and will only paint within this area. I will not paint on any curb or outside of my parking space.
- _____ I understand that my painted design must be completed on the designated paint days during the time outlined above.
- _____ If I do not abide by any of these rules, I realize my parking spot will have the paint removed and I will not receive a refund.
- _____ I will only paint my approved design following all the guidelines outlined in this packet.
