



SYMPTOMATIC

POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST »
Submit COVID-19 Reporting Form »
Stay Home » May return after:

- Completion of one quarantine scenario AND
- Improvement of symptoms AND
- Fever free for 24 hours without use of fever reducing medication

NEGATIVE PCR/MOLECULAR COVID-19 TEST OR ALTERNATE DIAGNOSIS
Submit COVID-19 Reporting Form »
May return after:

- 24 hours after symptoms improve AND
- 24 hours fever free without use of fever reducing medication

ASYMPTOMATIC

POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST, NO SYMPTOMS »
Submit COVID-19 Reporting Form »
Stay Home » May return after:

- Completion of one quarantine scenario

EXPOSED TO COVID-19 POSITIVE INDIVIDUAL AND SYMPTOM-FREE

CLOSE CONTACT WITH INDIVIDUAL WHO TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 »
Submit COVID-19 Reporting Form »

If exposure to the COVID-positive individual occurred in the HOUSEHOLD »

- All members of the household stay home regardless of vaccination status or recent COVID-19 recovery.
- Nurse will provide return date.

If exposure to the COVID-positive individual occurred in SCHOOL or the LOCAL COMMUNITY »

- Quarantine is not automatically required as long the exposed person remains symptom-free.
- Quarantine may be required for an exposed group due to possible community spread.
- Fully Vaccinated individuals or those who have fully recovered from COVID-19 within the last 3 months, are NOT required to quarantine.

AWAITING TEST RESULTS

INDIVIDUAL OR HOUSEHOLD MEMBER AWAITING COVID-19 TEST RESULTS
Submit COVID-19 Reporting Form »
If the person awaiting test results is SYMPTOMATIC »

- All members of the household stay home
- Report test result.

If the test was/is required due to travel or unrelated medical procedures (e.g., surgery) and the awaiting individual is SYMPTOM-FREE »

- May return to school.
- Report test result.

QUARANTINE SCENARIOS

WHEN QUARANTINE IS REQUIRED:

- 10 days following the date of LAST positive test or exposure to infected individual
- OR**
- 5 days WITH wearing a mask for 5 additional days - no mask exemptions.
